

How to Charge

If this is your first time driving an electric vehicle, we recommend you download a charging app from either Chargepoint or Flo. A charging app is usually required to start the charging stations (even if they are free).

Charger Level Breakdown

Level 1 - This is for getting that extra tiny bit overnight. This doesn't require any fancy outlet and can be used on any normal outlet - it's like charging your phone.

Level 2 - If you're low on charge the night before, a level 2 charging station will get you sorted overnight.

Level 3 - This is the fastest charging method currently available. A stop for lunch while charging on level 3 will get you back on the road!

Fees

Please make sure to return your vehicle with at least 70% charge! If you're unable to, we can do it for you, but at a charge.....

\$75 (50 - 69% charge)

\$125 (30 - 49% charge)

\$200 (0 - 29% charge)

Vehicles will also include a level 1 charging cable. If you lose the charging cable, you will be responsible for replacing it.

\$1,000 (replacement fee)

If your vehicle is missing the charging cable (located in the trunk under the floor), please text (438) 805-2617, and let us know.

It is also a great idea to take a photo of the cable upon return!

Charging Tip!

For maximum efficiency (and fastest charging rate), charge from 20 - 80% on a level 3 charger! The last 20% is slower.

Charging Map

EV charging maps are a great tool to plan out your trip and day. Finding the most accessible level 3 charging stations will help reduce your downtime. You can scan the QR code to open the PlugShare charging map. If you're using PlugShare's filter system, level 3 chargers start at 50 kW!



Charging Outlet Location

The charging outlet for the bZ4X is located on the front driver's side of the vehicle.
